

Negatives

Je ne joue pas : I do not play

Je ne joue jamais : I never play.

Je ne joue plus : I don't play any more

Je ne joue rien : I don't play anything

Reflexive Verbs

Reflexive verbs have an extra pronoun, which translates as 'myself', 'yourself', 'himself', etc.

Je **me** lave: I wash **myself**

Tu **te** laves: You wash **yourself**

Vous **vous** lavez: You wash **yourself**

Il **se** lave: He washes **himself**

Elle **se** lave: She washes **herself**

Ils **se** lavent: They wash **themselves**

Elles **se** lavent: They wash **themselves**

Asking Questions

1) You can ask a question just by using a different intonation, making your voice rise at the end:

Tu parles français?

2) You can ask a question by adding “est-ce que” at the front of the phrase:

Est-ce que tu parles français ?

3) You can ask a question by changing the word order and put the verb first (followed by a hyphen):

Parles-tu français?
