Your child will utilise their Glow account throughout their educational journey at Meldrum Academy. Glow can be accessed through a web browser at: <a href="https://glow.rmunify.com/">https://glow.rmunify.com/</a>. Your child's login is personal to them and is set up as follows — user: <a href="mailto:gw(number/name)@glow.sch.uk">gw(number/name)@glow.sch.uk</a>. If your child forgets their password, you can follow the 'forgotten your password' link or ask any member of teaching staff who can reset this. Glow connect - <a href="https://glowconnect.org.uk/">https://glowconnect.org.uk/</a> is the place to get information, help and support for Glow if you require.

#### **FREE Access to Microsoft products:**



You can access Microsoft products <u>for free</u> to support learning for your child via Glow. The link outlines how to download products (on up to 15 devices) via your child's glow, and how to log in. We utilise Microsoft products across all year groups in school to support and enhance learning and we highly recommend, where possible, downloading these products.

If you do not wish to download these products your child can work using the online version via Glow.

#### **Microsoft Teams:**



Microsoft Teams is our main interface/application for posting work/assignments (it can be downloaded free on an app store and/or via glow for a laptop/desktop device). It will be utilised for homework tasks (and some class work tasks) from this point forward and Show My Homework will be used mainly for basic notification of home work set. It is very important your child utilises this tool. Support for Microsoft Teams can be found by clicking this link <a href="https://support.microsoft.com/en-us/teams">https://support.microsoft.com/en-us/teams</a>.

We encourage your child to access Teams on a regular basis and take the time to show you as parents what Teams is like and what all is available for pupils to use to enhance their educational experience.



Show My Homework is a service we utilise in school to inform pupils and parents of homework set. A Show My Homework app (entitled Satchel One (previously SMHW)) can also be downloaded from your app store on a mobile device which allows for quick reference for any homework set. The initial log in requires you to search for the school and then gives you the option to enter the 'Pin or parental code' which has been distributed via your child. If you have previously logged in, you can access using your normal log in details.

Please note - Show My Homework will be utilised only to provide a basic outline of tasks to pupils and parents and homework details will be provided by Microsoft Teams as a more intuitive and accessible platform. Any messages sent by pupils/parents on SMHW may not be replied to as we encourage the use of the Microsoft Teams channel and glow emails.
