

This document contains a summary of the responses provided to the parental questionnaire issued in November 2023. On this occasion we received a total of 125 parental responses. This compares with 110 responses in June 2023.

The questions used are those asked of parents/carers by His Majesty's Inspectorate of Education (HMIe) prior to any school inspection visit. Rather than ask all parents/carers to answer the full HMIe questionnaire, our form asks parents of pupils in determined year groups a different subset of questions from the HMIe questionnaire.

Questions were separated into three themes and the online form branched to allow responses from parents of specific year groups as follows:

S1 and S4	Health and Wellbeing / Pastoral Support
S2 and S5	Parental Involvement and School Leadership
S3 and S6	Teaching, Learning, Tracking and Monitoring

Three questions were asked to all parents regardless of their child's year group.


We will continue to gather information twice-yearly and share a summary of responses with our staff and parental body.

The summary of responses provided is presented both in tabular and graph form as follows:








