



This document contains a summary of the responses provided to the pupil questionnaire issued in November 2023. On this occasion we received a total of 215 pupil responses. This compares with 240 responses to the survey issues in November 2023. The breakdown of responses by year and house groups is:





The questions used are those asked of pupils by His Majesty's Inspectorate of Education (HMIe) prior to any school inspection visit. All pupils were asked the full set of questions.


We will continue to gather information twice-yearly and share a summary of these responses with our pupils.

The summary of responses provided is presented both in tabular and graph form as follows:




